# ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The YAI Youth Championship, will be hosted by the Royal Mysore Sailing Club under the aegis of Royal Madras Yacht Club, (RMYC Mysore, Center) the Karnataka State Sailing Association, respective Class Associations and The Yachting Association of India.

## RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS).
- 1.2 In all rules governing this event, the notations;
  - a. [SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee or technical committee without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.
  - b. [NP] denotes a rule for which a breach of that rule shall not be grounds for protests by another boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- 1.3 The Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.5 [DP][NP] Protocols relating to COVID 19 may be published at any time and will have the status of a rule.

## SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available after completion of registration on 29 Jul 2022 at Venue.



# ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to all members of clubs affiliated/registered with YAI and the respective Class Associations and whose subscription/dues are fully paid up where necessary.
- 3.2 The event will be sailed in the following classes for the purpose of ranking:-
- Optimist (Open).
  - ILCA 6 (Boys & Girls).
  - ILCA 4 (Boys & Girls). ILCA 4 shall be under 18 yrs (the age the competitor becomes in the year of the championship).
  - RS One (Boys & Girls)
- 3.3 All Optimist sailors must be born on or after 01 Jan 2009. Valid, parent attested Proof of Age is to be provided at the time of Registration for all fleets
- 3.4 The entry closing date is 21 Jul 2022.
- 3.5 Late entries may be accepted till 29 Jul 2022 only at the discretion of the organisers/host club upon payment of an additional late entry fee of Rs. 2000/-.

## NOTE:

Each sailor of Optimist / ILCA 4 class shall submit a signed/guardian consent form. For the duration of the championship each Optimist / ILCA 4 class sailor shall be accompanied by a responsible adult who is named on the parental/guardian consent form.



# FEES

4.1 The entry fees will be as follows:-

a. Optimist - 3500 INR

b. ILCA 4/6 - 4500 INR

c. Fee for registration of Coaches/Team Manager- 4000 INR

4.2 Affiliation certificate from respective Club/State association is mandatory for registration as Coach/Team Manager

4.3 Entry fees includes lunch on racing days, attendance for select functions / ceremonies and certificates as applicable.

4.4 Entry fees does not include boarding and lodging.

4.5 Entry fees will not be refunded under any circumstance unless the entry is not accepted.

# ADVERTISING

5.1 Competitor advertising will be restricted to World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code

5.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.



# FORMAT

6.1 All classes will sail a single series of fleet races.

# SCHEDULE

7.1 The initial Competitors Briefing will be held at 1000 hrs. on 30 Jul 2022 at the Royal Mysore Sailing Club.

7.2 The Event Schedule is as follows:-

7.3 A total of 12 races per class are scheduled. Each class is scheduled to sail three (03) races per day, but may sail one additional race per day.

7.4 No warning signal will be made after 1200 hrs. on 04 Aug 2022.



# EQUIPMENT INSPECTION AND MEASUREMENT

- 8.1 All IODA Optimists shall produce a valid Registration Book and Sail Measurement Certificate. To be enclosed with the Entry form.
- 8.2 Laser Sailors who are sharing the same hull for ILCA 6 & 4 have to present themselves for Equipment Inspection together. They have to also be present with their sail, bottom section and boom.
- 8.3 The Race/Technical Committee or its appointed representative reserves the right to check/measure the racing equipment and eligibility of sailor at any time during the Championship.

## VENUE

- 9.1 The shore venue is Royal Mysore Sailing Club, Blue Lagoon Inn, KRS Backwaters, Mysore, KN Pin 571130
- 9.2 The races will be held in Krishna Raja Sagar, Mysore

## COURSES

- 10.1 The Courses will be Trapezoidal & Windward/Leeward or any other course as described in the sailing instructions.



# PENALTY SYSTEM

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11.1 Appendix 'P' will apply.

# PROTEST COMMITTEE

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12.1 A protest committee will be appointed in accordance with RRS 91 (a).

# SCORING

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13.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will be used except as modified as follows: -

13.2 Four (04) races are required to be completed to constitute a series for all categories.

- 13.3 a. When six or fewer than six (06) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b. When Eight (08) or more races but less than eleven races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- c. When more than Ten (10) races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst score.

# [DP] SUPPORT PERSON VESSEL

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- 14.1 All support person boats shall stay outside the racing area (minimum 100 m) from the time of the first warning signal for the first class to start till completion of racing for the day.
- 14.2 Support person boats will be marked with their club insignia or WITH white flag.

## **[DP] BERTHING**

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- 15.3 Boats will be kept in the assigned places while they are in the boat park.

## **[DP] RADIO COMMUNICATION**

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- 16.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

## **RISK STATEMENT**

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- 17.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is here alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by





other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

18.2 Medals in each category will be given as follows:-

- a. 03 entries (minimum) - Gold Medal only
- b. 4 or 5 entries - Gold and Silver Medal only
- c. 6 or more entries - Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal



18.3 Sailors can participate in different rigs of the ILCA Class, for example in ILCA 4 as well as in ILCA 6.

18.4 Additional prizes may be awarded by OA in different age categories depending upon the entries.
